Be the type of friend that's there for their <u>ACCOMPLISHMENTS</u> as well as for their <u>ADVERSITIES.</u>

"Timothy was **WELL THOUGHT OF** by the believers in Lystra and Iconium," Acts 16:2

Paul wanted to take him along on the journey, so he circumcised him because of the Jews who lived in that area, for they all knew that his father was a Greek." Acts 16:3

"but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him." Luke 2:44-45

"Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions." Luke 2:46

"And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers." Luke 2:47

I would dare say that those who aren't TEACHABLE will eventually become REPLACEABLE.

"Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28

We love with **NO STRINGS ATTACHED**, because God's love for us came with **NO STRINGS ATTACHED**.

"I have no one else like Timothy, <u>WHO GENUINELY CARES</u> about your welfare." Philippians 2:20

We don't show love to try to get something \underline{FROM} others, we show love to try TO get something \underline{TO} others.

Love one another **DEEPLY** as brothers and sisters. Outdo one another in showing honor. Romans 12:10
